

## LESSON 6 – DEALING WITH CONFLICTS

### SHARING MATERIALS

Two kids both want to use the same marker, toy, or game.



### TAKING TURNS

Arguing over who gets to go first in a game or activity.



### EXCLUSION

A group leaves someone out of a game or project.



### NAME CALLING

Someone teases or calls another person a mean name.



### CHEATING IN A GAME

A player doesn't follow the rules, and others get upset.



### ACCUSATIONS

Someone is blamed for something they didn't do.





## LINE CUTTING

One child cuts in line at recess, lunch, or the bus.



## LOST OR BROKEN ITEM

A borrowed item is returned broken, or goes missing.



## DIFFERENT OPINIONS

Friends disagree about what game to play or what rules to use.



## GROUP PROJECT STRUGGLES

One child isn't helping, or others won't let them contribute.



## FRIENDSHIP JEALOUSY

One child feels left out when their friend plays with someone else.



## INTERRUPTING

Someone keeps cutting others off while talking.
